PREVENTION OF DEFACEMENT OF PUBLIC PROPERTY DURING DUSU ELECTIONS: 2019-2020

The process of DUSU elections 2019-2020 has begun in the University of Delhi. The candidates and their supporters have started canvassing in and around the colleges. During

canvassing the candidates should follow the Code of Conduct.

According to the Code of Conduct, sticking of posters etc. is banned and these can be pasted

only on the earmarked places i.e. Wall of Democracy. Moreover, Section 3 of "The West

Bengal Defacement of Property Act 1976" also reads as under:-

Section - 3 :- Penalty for Defacement of Property - (1) Whoever defaces any property in

public view by writing or marking with ink, chalk, paint or any other material, except for the

purpose of indicating the name and address of the owner or occupier of such property, shall

be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may be extend to six months or with fine

which may extend to one thousand rupees or with both. (2) Where any offence committed

under Sub-Section (1) is for the benefit of some other person or a company or other body

corporate or an association of persons (whether incorporated or not), then such other

person and every President, Chairman, Director, Partner, Manager, Secretary, Agent and

any other officer or person concerned with the management thereof, as the case may be,

shall unless he proves that the offence was committed without his knowledge or consent,

be deemed to be guilty of such offence.
